“Healing in the Developing World and Care of the Underserved: Medical and Theological Considerations” is a course that examines issues related to health and healing in underserved populations through an integrated lens of medicine, health, and theology. Students examine health from the perspective of both individuals and communities and explore societal factors that contribute to the process of healing. During the course, students spend one week in Haiti. As an interdisciplinary course, students from the schools of medicine, nursing, divinity, undergraduate, etc. work together to critically examine the process of providing culturally relevant assistance to underserved communities.
